STUDY PROGRAMME

The Physiotherapy study programme is a three-year long course which focuses on theoretical and clinical knowledge in the biomedical field and the field related to humanities. This course teaches practical skills in fields such as physical therapy, kinesiotherapy and pathokinesiology, which are necessary for diagnosis and therapy of functional and structural diseases of the skeletomuscular system and related organ systems. It also takes into consideration psychological problems and the therapy of syndromes related to musculoskeletal systems, analysing problems from different aspects in complexity.

The education prepares specialists who are competent and certified to practise physiotherapy and functionally diagnose in rehabilitation centres (inpatient or outpatient), health spas, welfare centres or in a private practice.

STUDIES

The Physiotherapy programme is a full-time course with a specific and technical character that includes a minimum of three years of study and a minimum of 4 064 hours of theoretical and practical lessons. 1 852 hours are practical workshops. A student must obtain 180 credits (ECTS) during his/her studies.

GRADUATE PROFILE

A graduate is a specialist with a university degree in Physiotherapy who cooperates with doctors and performs diagnostic, therapeutic and preventive techniques, and methods in the rehabilitation process in the physiotherapy field. He/she focuses on functional or organic motor disorders and chronic pain in the musculoskeletal system of ill patients.

ADMISSION

The admission to study Physiotherapy will be assessed in three steps: a written test (high school level knowledge in anatomy and psychology), a talent exam (motor activities) and an oral exam.

TUITION FEES

64 000 CZK / academic year (divided into two payments which are due at the beginning of semester)
