STUDY PROGRAMME

This three-year bachelor program in General Nursing focuses on obtaining theoretical and practical skills to become a registered nurse. General Nursing is studied in blocks of theoretical lessons, practical lessons and practical training in one semester. Students acquire a universal and systematic approach in nursing care, an appropriate attitude and ability to make decisions in demanding and unstable situations.

STUDIES

The General Nursing programme is a full-time or combined course. The standard length of study is three years and includes a minimum of 4 600 hours of theoretical and practical lessons, and a minimum of 2 300 and maximum of 3 000 hours of practical training. Students must obtain 180 credits (ECTS) during their studies.

GRADUATE PROFILE

A graduate of General Nursing receives complex knowledge for practising the profession of a registered nurse. A graduate is a university certified specialist in the nursing field. Graduates of General Nursing are able to continue (after meeting requirements) in an arbitrary master's degree.

During their studies, students are certified for professions such as a health care assistant, a practical nurse and a hospital attendant.

ADMISSION

The admission to study General Nursing in full-time study is assessed with a written test on high school level anatomy and psychology. Applicants interested in part-time mode of study are accepted without an entrance exam.

TUITION FEES

34 000 CZK / academic year (divided into two payments which are due at the beginning of each semester)
